

STATEWIDE IMPACT STATS

Each year the Department of Labor and Industry's Center for Workforce Information and Analysis provides SEWN with the greater economic impact of the manufacturing jobs saved. During the 2023-24 program year, SEWN saved over 3400 jobs (including indirect and induced jobs), contributed over a billion dollars to Pennsylvania's total economic output, resulting in over \$100 million in state and local tax revenue.

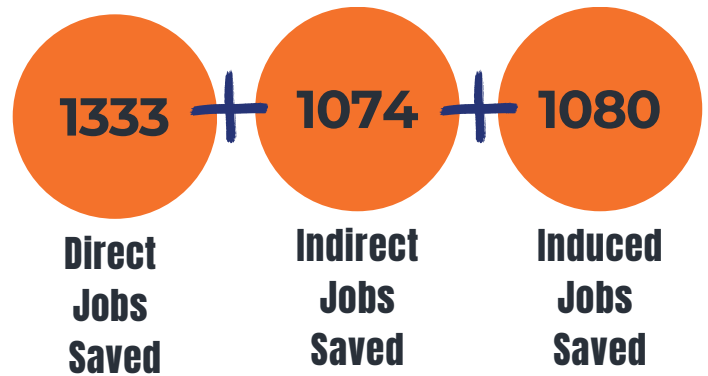

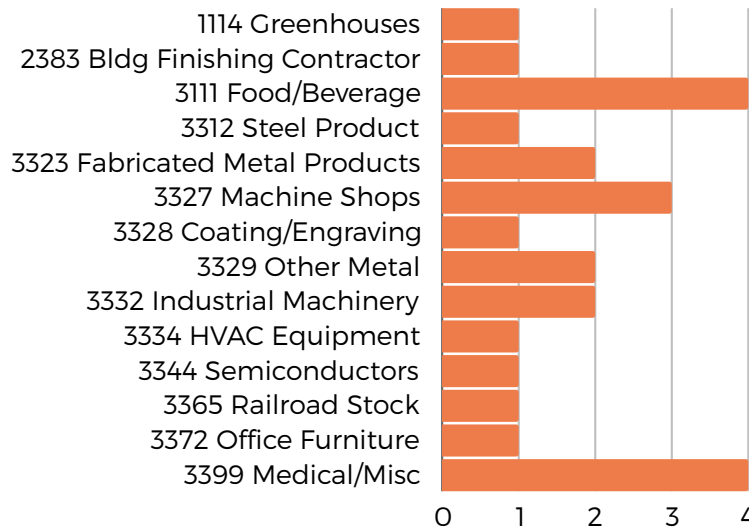

IMPACT METRICS

Over the last five (5) program years, SEWN has saved jobs at an average of \$1,250 per job saved. Over 5900 manufacturing jobs were retained during this time, saving the Commonwealth more than **\$38.1 million** in Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation benefits, and nearly **\$1 billion** if jobs/payroll multipliers are included.
